Cyprus Music Service

The Cyprus Music Service (CMS) commenced in the Autumn Term of 1999. The aim of the Cyprus Music Service is to make instrumental tuition available to Service children presently educated in Cyprus and to provide musical opportunities that will enrich their lives and build skills for the future.

There are two centres: WSBA and ESBA. The main administrative base for Cyprus Music Service is at WSBA, based at St. John's School, Episkopi. The second unit is based at King Richard School, Dhekelia.

The instrumental tuition comes as a 'package' consisting of two main elements:

Firstly, the pupil will receive small group lessons in his/her own school during the school week. All our staff are highly qualified instrumental specialists who will be available to teach a minimum of 30 lessons each year.

Secondly, after an initial period of tuition, the pupil will be *expected* to attend a Music School which will operate at a Music Centre in their Sovereign Base Area. These practical schools operate at various times during the week, outside normal school hours. It is here that the pupil will experience playing in larger bands, orchestras and other instrumental ensembles.

The Cyprus Music Service primarily offers tuition in woodwind, brass and stringed instruments. However, should timetabling, staffing and schools permit,

we will always consider applications for other instruments. At present, tuition is available for pupils in Y3 and above. Please complete the application form stating your requirement; we may be able to help.

Every child will be given a suitability test once an application form has been returned, but tuition will not be able to commence until all completed documentation and payment is received at the WSBA Centre office.

Tuition

Pupils are entitled to a $\frac{1}{2}$ hour lesson in a small group of no more than 3. Individual lessons are of a minimum of 15 minutes duration. The instrumental teacher will be available to teach a minimum of 30 lessons in a year.

Tuition Costs

Termly tuition fees are €67.50, this is for the weekly lessons. Payment for each term will be by cash or a Euro cheque, made payable to Cyprus Music Service Fees.

Instruments are available from Cyprus Music Service and these are loaned to children for a nominal charge whilst they are receiving tuition.
